APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF August 8, 2013

Motion by Mr. Miks to approve the minutes of July 25, 2013: seconded by Mr. Shaver; carried 6-0

Item 1. Show Cause Hearing for alleged Code of Laws Violation at El Jaliciense, LLC, dba "El Jaliciense", 4105 Wadsworth Blvd, Wheat Ridge, Colorado, 80033

Mr. Roome introduced the item.

Aurelio Padilla-Talabera, Owner and Carl Ream, Attorney was present from El Jaliciense, LLC.

Opening Statements

Mr. Price explained to the Liquor Authority that the alleged violation occurred on January 27, 2013 and as of today Mr. Padilla-Talabera has sold the business to another owner. In order to avoid further delay Mr. Padilla-Talabera has agreed to stipulate that on January 27, 2013 he did sell to a visibly intoxicated person. Mr. Padilla-Talabera has also agreed to a five day suspension as part of this stipulation.

Violation Phase

Motion by Mr. Miks that on January 27, 2013 a violation of CRS Section 12-47-901(5)(a)(I) did occur by serving/selling alcohol to a visibly intoxicated person; seconded by Mr. Davis; carried 6-0.

Motion by Mr. Miks to direct the City Attorney to prepare findings for this meeting and further move to suspend the license of El Jaliciense, LLC, dba "El Jaliciense", 4105 Wadsworth Blvd, Wheat Ridge, Colorado, 80033 for a period of 5 days. The days are to be served from September 5, 2013 to September 9, 2013.

Seconded by Mr. Alldredge; carried 6-0.

CITY CLERK'S MATTERS

The liquor license training for the liquor authority provided by WRPD and the State Liquor Enforcement Division will again need to be rescheduled, maybe have it after a liquor meeting.

There are five files on the Deputy City Clerk's desk in various stages of completion, three are new licenses and two are transfer of ownerships.
