The Wheat Ridge Police Department is looking for the individual responsible for a theft at Action Recycling at W. 42nd and Wadsworth. On 12/26/14, a male suspect entered the Wardle Feed and Pet Supply and was seen on surveillance video attempting to access the cash drawer. The suspect then walked next door to Action Recycling where he stole a cashbox containing a large amount of cash. The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, 25-30 years old, 5'7", 160 lbs. He has been observed wearing a black cap with an Under Armour logo or a black beret style hat with a black hoodie, black jacket and black gloves. The suspect left in a silver 2005 Dodge Durango (unknown plates), but also may be associated with a red 2000 Ford F350 truck with Texas plates.
