TITLE: A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING A BALLOT QUESTION TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE CITY, CONCERNING CITY WIDE RESIDENTIAL TRASH REMOVAL

WHEREAS, multiple trash trucks in residential neighborhoods cause premature damage to streets and infrastructure which requires tax dollars to repair; and

WHEREAS, multiple trash trucks in residential neighborhoods contribute to added noise and air pollution; and

WHEREAS, the Wheat Ridge City Council desires the best price and customer service for citizens with regard to residential trash removal, including recycling, within the City of Wheat Ridge; and

WHEREAS, the Wheat Ridge City Council wishes to determine whether citizens support city-wide residential trash removal, including recycling, in the form of a franchise or franchises; and

WHEREAS, the Wheat Ridge Home Rule Charter requires a vote of the electorate to approve the granting of a franchise; and

WHEREAS, if the electorate of the City authorizes the grant of a franchise for residential trash removal, including recycling, the Council intends to obtain the most favorable terms for the same, including price and schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Wheat Ridge City Council:

Section 1. The City Council hereby submits and refers the following ballot question to the registered electors of the City at the November 2, 2010 general election.

Ballot Question No. _____:

SHALL THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEAT RIDGE, COLORADO BE AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO A FRANCHISE OR FRANCHISES FOR CITY-WIDE RESIDENTIAL TRASH REMOVAL, INCLUDING RECYCLING AND A SENIOR DISCOUNT, FOR SINGLE FAMILY AND DUPLEX ZONE DISTRICTS?


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
