Clancy's Irish Pub Celebrates New Location with Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

BACKGROUND: Established in 1973, Clancy's Irish Pub is Wheat Ridge's oldest pub. The bar and restaurant was formerly located at 38th Avenue and Kipling Boulevard, but opened in a new, 6,000-square-foot location earlier this month after a year-long hiatus. Now housed at the Ridge at 38, Clancy's features two dining areas and a large, covered patio. The venue is open from 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. daily.
