Shots fired along Kipling Street

Wheat Ridge, CO ~ During the early morning hours of February 15, 2015 the police department received an alarm from an Auto Zone located in the 3700 block of Kipling Street. Responding officers determined a projectile had struck a window on the business, shattering the outside pane. The business was not open at the time; the projectile was not recovered.

On February 22 police responded back to the same business and found three additional windows had been broken in the same manner. No projectiles were recovered.

On the night of May 9 an RTD bus was driving north on Kipling Street in the 3700 block when the driver heard a loud popping noise and found a hole in one of the top windows on the side of the bus. A small caliber bullet was recovered from the interior of the bus a short time later. No passengers were on the bus at the time. At approximately the same time as the bus incident two windows in a home in the 3500 block of Kipling were struck by bullets. No one inside the home was injured. A bullet located inside the home appears similar to the bullet found in the RTD bus.
