Grand Opening of Clear Creek Trail and Completion of Kipling Trail

WHO: City of Wheat Ridge and the Active Transportation Advisory Team (ATAT)

WHAT: Ribbon Cutting to celebrate the opening of the Clear Creek Trailhead and the completion of the Kipling Multi-Use Trail.

Cyclists will meet at 8:30 a.m. near Wheat Ridge High School across the street on 32nd to ride down the hill on the new section of the Kipling Trail, through Discovery Park, across the bridge and into the parking lot at the Kipling Trailhead. The ride will start at 9 a.m. and end at the park for the ribbon cutting at 9:15 a.m.

WHEN: Sat. Oct. 15, 2016

Cyclists meet at Wheat Ridge High School 8:30 a.m.; Ribbon Cutting 9:15 a.m.

Helmets are required!

WHERE: East side of Kipling in the parking lot of the Kipling Trailhead. North of the Wheat Ridge Recreation Center

Parking is limited. Please park at the Wheat Ridge Recreation Center or Everitt Middle School. Crossing Kipling on a busy Saturday morning is not advised so if parking at the Rec. Ctr. Take the tunnel UNDER Kipling

INFO: Mayor Joyce Jay and members of city staff, ATAT and Wheat Ridge Police will join members of the community to ride the trail north to the Kipling Trailhead for the Ribbon Cutting ceremony at 9:15 a.m. After a few remarks, the ribbon will be cut officially opening both the Clear Creek Trail and the newly completed Kipling Multi-Use Trail. Refreshments will be served and members of ATAT will be on hand to answer questions about the trail. Representatives from the city will also attend to share information and solicit input on the Bike/Pedestrian Plan.
