

What's Happened?

On December 12, over 100 Wheat Ridge residents attended a community open house open house at the Recreation Center hosted by the steering committee. The steering committee is comprised of 26 residents impaneled by City Council to guide the NRS project. The open house provided information about the project's background, preliminary









What's Next?



The steering committee will continue its work over the winter, thinking about ways the City of Wheat Ridge can respond to its most pressing opportunities and challenges. Input gathered from the open house will inform next steps as the committee moves from identifying issues to developing possible actions.



In early 2019, additional engagement opportunities will take place, including a planned public survey in February. Public events to share progress and gather new and different public feedback are tentatively planned for March.



The consulting team will also continue its analysis of Wheat Ridge data and policy issues. Draft strategy concepts will begin to take shape over the winter and a draft strategy document is expected in the spring.
