Wheat Ridge Police Respond to Shooting

WHEAT RIDGE, Colo. April 13, 2020 – Wheat Ridge Police responded to 33rd Ave. and Chase St. at approximately midnight April 12, 2020, on a report of a shooting. One juvenile male was found deceased in a car that had crashed at that location and another was transported to a local hospital.

Police believe the incident began at Panorama Park and detectives will continue their investigation today. There doesn't appear to be any threat to the public. Anyone with information is asked to call WRPD at 303-235-2947.
